Admissions

Hopewell Academy is a college preparatory academy designed for college bound or career-oriented students who benefit from small group instruction in an educational environment that emphasizes organization, structure, and multi-sensory instruction.

Hopewell Academy maintains a small teacher - student ratio. Each core class is staffed by a highly qualified teacher (often between 10:1 to 15:1). Each student is assigned to an Advisor/Mentor that follows the student throughout school. In addition to the Lower School and the High School Degree Programs, Hopewell offers Summer Session, After School Programs, Camps, Athletics, and Tutorials.

General Policies

1. Space permitting, Hopewell Academy offers multi-season admissions in which students may be admitted throughout the year.
2. Prior to the interview with the student, the school requires parents to complete an application and have copies of transcripts, testing, and letters of evaluation or recommendation sent to the school.
3. Whenever possible, the school desires that both parents attend school admissions interviews.
4. Students need not be enrolled in Hopewell Academy to participate in Hopewell camps and other programs.

Tuition and Fees

Tuition

Hopewell Academy features small classes focused on the individual. We offer highly qualified teachers, and a variety of arts, athletics and after school activities. Hopewell's Tuition and Fees Schedules are established and published annually in January for the following school year.

Tuition is an annual charge and payable according to our Admissions Contract. Students admitted after the start of the school year are eligible for tuition adjustments based on the quarter in which they are admitted.

Fees

As with most private schools, tuition alone is not sufficient to pay the costs incurred in delivering quality education to your student. Schools typically recover these costs through fees, fundraisers, and new student fees. Fees cover specific costs for programs such as field trips. Fundraising covers costs for unique or large-scale programs. The PTO and Booster Clubs are mechanisms to fund specific programs. Lastly, New Student Fees and Donations foster the short and long-term financial health of our school.

Tuition Discounts

Families enrolling multiple students will be offered a sibling tuition discount. Students enrolling after the start of the academic year are offered a prorated tuition table based on the full quarter in which they enroll. 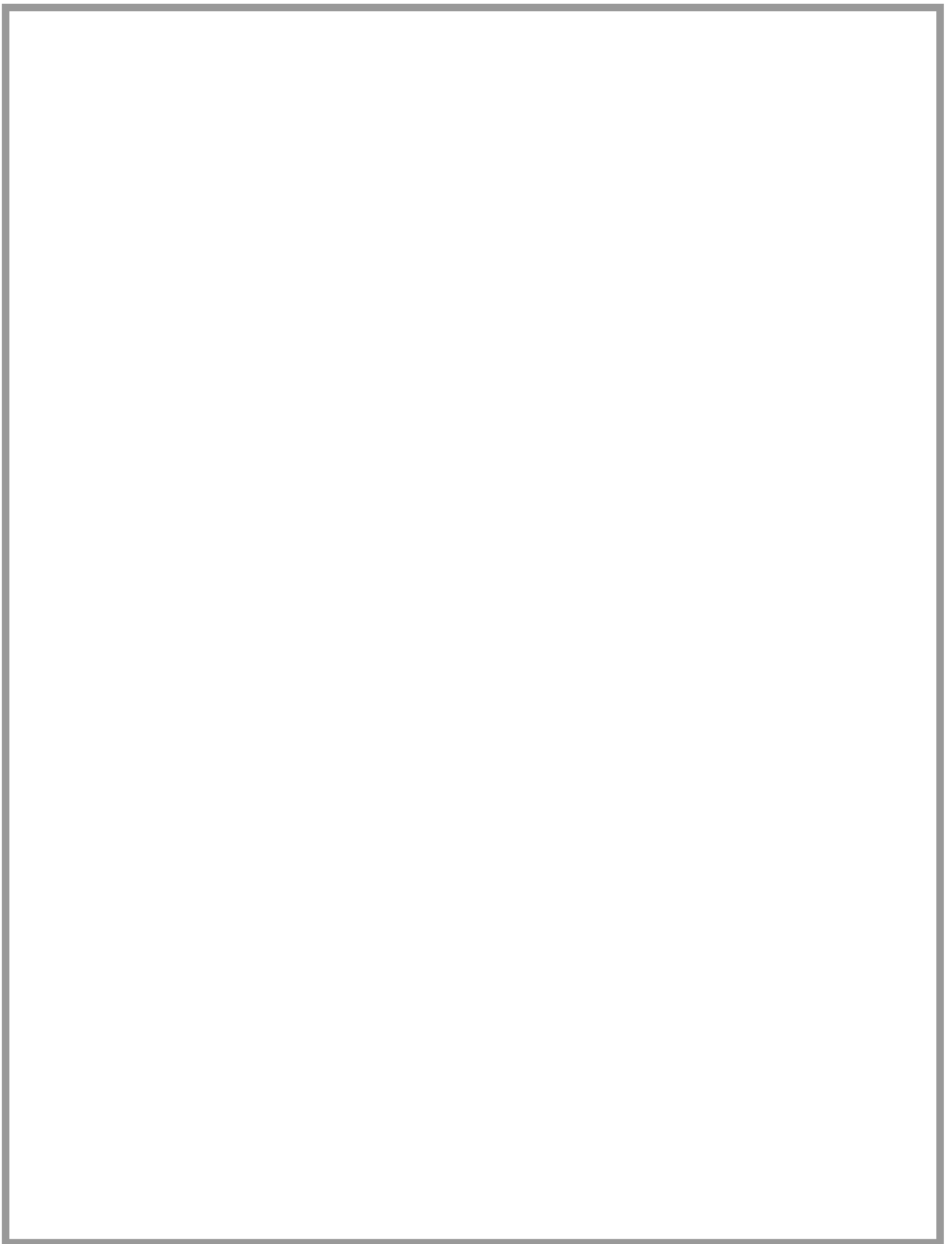
